Food Box Collection

Many families in Madison County struggle with food insecurity, meaning they don't know where their next meal will come from. Here at Madison Park Church, it is our desire to be a part of the solution in eradicating hunger in our community. One of the ways MP Missions works towards this goal is through the Food Boxes for Anderson High School. Students who struggle with hunger rely on the meals provided at school. 2 week breaks for students is extremely challenging, so we partner with the school social worker to provide boxes filled with meals for the students' breaks. It is our goal to provide at least 100 full boxes for each break.
